

CARECOMPARE COOKIE NOTICE

A cookie is a small file of data which is stored on your computer or mobile when you visit a website.

We use cookies to:

- remember information about you, so you don't have to provide it again;
- keep you signed in, even on different devices
- help us understand how people use our website and services so we can improve them;
- help us personalise your experience of our website by remembering your preferences and settings;
- help us monitor your progress (e.g. when providing us with information), so you can pick up where you left off;

We use:

Strictly necessary cookies: These are cookies which are necessary for the operation of our website. They are always on when you visit our website, and they can't be turned off.

Analytical/performance cookies: These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our website and to see how visitors move around our website. This helps us to improve the way our website works, e.g. by ensuring that users can easily find what they are looking for.

We use these only if you have given your consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time by clearing the cookies and cache in your browser.

Functionality cookies: These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. They allow us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences.

We use these only if you have given your consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time by clearing the cookies and cache in your browser.

Third party cookies

Third parties (e.g. [advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services]) may also use cookies, over which we have no control.
